

ADMISSION POLICY AND PROCESS

UG Programmes:

- Admissions will be made for UG Degree programmes, on the basis of Score obtained in the Common University Entrance Test (CUET-UG) merit based Counselling will be conducted by the Admission Monitoring Committee (AMC) of VMRF-DU and the eligibility criteria prescribed by VMRF-DU rules & regulations from time to time.
- For prospective vacant seats (if any) after CUET-UG Counselling, on the basis of the Merit of the Qualifying (10+2) examination through counselling.

PG Programmes:

- Admissions will be made for PG Degree programmes, on the basis of Score obtained in the Common University Entrance Test (CUET-PG) merit based Counselling will be conducted by the Admission Monitoring Committee (AMC) of VMRF-DU and the eligibility criteria prescribed by VMRF-DU rules & regulations from time to time.
- For prospective vacant seats (if any) after CUET-PG Counselling, on the basis of the Merit of the Qualifying examination through counselling.

Admission Guidelines

- Admission notification will be published in reputed dailies in Regional Language and in English.
- Students or parents or guardians shall buy the application and prospectus and apply to the University within the stipulated time of Admissions.
- During admission to the Arts & Science courses, students should bring their parents or guardians with them.
- If the students required bus facility or hostel facility, requisition form should be submitted in the office.
- Opening day of the college will be intimated by post.

Enclosures

- Original Transfer Certificate
- Three copies of attested mark sheet of qualifying examinations.
- Migration Certificate in the case of CBSE candidates / other Universities outside Tamilnadu.
- Eligibility Certificate from this University the case of students from CBSE, other states & countries for UG Courses and Students from other Universities and other countries for PG Courses.
- Recent passport size photograph to be affixed in the space provided in the application form. (Ten photos to be brought at the time of admission)
- Original Community certificate.
- Students from other countries should submit a copy of passport and Visa. (They have to produce the original whenever necessary).
- Physical Fitness Certificate from a competent authority.
